

## Frequently asked questions for national mass vaccination campaign from 7 September to 10 September 2021:

- **Where are the BRAC-managed vaccination centres located?**

Here is the list of the nine vaccination centres in Dhaka city which are managed by BRAC, in collaboration with the respective ward councilor's office:

- **Are COVID-19 vaccine centres open for all?**

The centres are **only open to those who have taken their first dose at the same centre** in the mass vaccination campaign held in August 2021.

- **When can I visit the vaccination centre?**

Candidates can come to any of BRAC-managed centres from 9am to 3pm.

- **Which documents do I need to bring?**  
A photocopy of candidates' National Identity Card (NID) must be brought to the centre with the candidates' mobile number written on it, along with the vaccination card that was provided to you after the first dose in August 2021.
- **How much money does the vaccine dose cost?**  
COVID-19 vaccines are free of cost.
- **Is there any helpline number?**  
Anyone can call 16263 or 333 for any query relating to COVID-19.
- **Will I get a vaccination certificate if I get vaccinated in BRAC vaccination centres?**  
Yes, everyone who receives the COVID-19 vaccine will receive a vaccination certificate.
- **Which vaccines are given in the BRAC vaccination centres?**  
The Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is given at BRAC's vaccination centres.
- **I am pregnant, can I still get my COVID-19 vaccine?**  
Please consult with your gynecologist first. You can get the vaccine with your doctor's recommendation, which must be included in a prescription. You must bring the prescription to the centre.
- **I have given my first dose of COVID-19 vaccine in July, can I take my second dose now?**  
No, only those who received the first dose in August 2021 (during the first round of the mass vaccination campaign), are eligible to take the second dose.
- **Can my family member take the vaccine with my vaccine card?**  
No, only you are eligible to get vaccinated using your vaccine card.
- **I am COVID-19 positive, can I still take my second vaccine dose?**  
No, please consult with your doctor if you have any further questions.
- **Can I go to a different centre than the one where I received my first dose?**  
No, you cannot change the centre.
