

Located in the south-west of Bangladesh, Jhalokathi district lies under Barisal division, with an area of 758 square kilometres. The main rivers are the Garai, Kumar, Nabaganga, Begabati, Chitra, Bairab, Kobadak, Kodla, Phatki, Kaliganga and Ichamati. It is bounded by Barisal district on the north and east, Barguna district and the Bishkhali river on the south, and Lohagara and Pirojpur districts on the west.

BRAC operates in Jhalokathi with components, such as microfinance, health, nutrition and population (HNPP), community empowerment (CEP), human rights and legal aid services (HRLS), and targeting the ultra poor (TUP) programme.
